Dear Mr. Sawyer,

I am writing to inform you that the Attorney General's Office has received correspondence involving a possible campaign finance law violation. A copy of the correspondence is enclosed; it alleges that lawn signs related to the local election held March 6, 2018, did not include disclosure information that may be required by Vermont's campaign finance laws, including 17 V.S.A. § 2972.

We are not aware of prior complaints of a similar nature regarding your campaign materials. In addition, we understand at this time that there may have been inadvertent omissions with respect to disclosures on lawn signs related to the Town of Bennington March 6, 2018 election. The Attorney General's Office will therefore take no further action with regard to this matter at this time. Please take care, however, that any future advertisements meet the requirements of 17 V.S.A. § 2972, which requires electioneering communications to "contain the name and mailing address of the person, candidate, political committee, or political party that paid for the communication."

Should you decide to campaign again, you must comply with all applicable campaign finance laws. Information about Vermont's campaign finance laws is available through the Secretary of State's website at: https://www.sec.state.vt.us/elections.aspx.

I am writing to inform you that the Attorney General's Office has received the attached complaint of a possible campaign finance law violation by your organization. The complaint alleges that Citizens Against Article Two has received and expended contributions without filing disclosures with the Secretary of State's Office, contrary to Vermont's Campaign Finance Laws, including 17 V.S.A. § 2922. Publicly available information shows the filing of a campaign finance report by Citizens Against Article Two on February 25, 2018, and previously on February 13, 2018.

The Attorney General's Office has a role in the enforcement of Vermont's campaign finance laws. See 17 V.S.A. § 2904. We would like to give you an opportunity to respond to the complaint. Please provide us with a written response to the allegations by Monday April 9, 2018.

In particular, your response should address whether Citizens Against Article Two has filed disclosures with the Secretary of State's Office since February 25, 2018, and provide us with copies of any such documents.

I am filing this complaint against Citizens Against Article Two (Aaron Sawyer registrant) in light of the fact the political action committee did not file a required disclosure report on activities related to the March 6, 2018 Town Meeting.

Citizens Against Article Two's 2/24 filing shows \$1,143 raised. Mr. Sawyer <u>went on record</u> saying his PAC sent out 1,700 postcards in support of their cause. I received one of the graphics-heavy postcards with a stamp. Postcard stamps cost 34 cents, which comes out to \$578. CAAT also plastered the town with between 30 and 100 lawn signs.
