I am writing in response to your Feb. 27 reply to my Feb. 13 public records request regarding documents related to the investigation by the Vermont Attorney General's Office into allegations of racial harassment and other crimes against Kiah Morris.

I have discussed our request with Mark Davis of Vermont Public Radio, who had earlier submitted a similar public records request to the Vermont Attorney General's Office.

I will be joining him in paying for the cost of the documents in his request.

In addition, the Vermont Attorney General's Office's response dated Jan. 24 to Davis' request stated there are 477 pages of records responsive to his request while the response to my request on Feb. 27 indicated only 217 pages of records are available for public disclosure.

I am seeking a summary of those records that are being withheld from public disclosure, as well as the exemptions being cited for withholding those documents under Vermont's Public Records Act.
