The top of the window is entitled "THE THRILLS COMBO SAVES YOU UP TO \$444.00" then it lists 6 items, one of which is called "Flight FlexNo Change Fees! Modify for FREE via Spirit.com up to 24 hrs before departure - Subject to fare difference". At the bottom are two boxes to select fromA) \$9 Fare Club and save \$444.00 (\$60.99 PP ea way); and B) Standard and save \$384.00 (\$75.99 PP ea way). I had to change my reservation to same date but later time & was charged \$360.00 Change Fee. I called to dispute the fee & was told that since I didn't select the "thrills combo" when making the original reservation there was nothing Spirit could do. I'm complaining because their website is VERY DECEPTIVE in stating "Thrills Combo saves you up to \$444.00 & the two options to select are called "\$9 Fare Club" and "Standard"and further the \$9 Fare Club box reflects the same verbage "and Save \$444.00" as the header of the window. One can normally assume then that all 6 listed items are included when you select the \$9 Fare Club box!!! Why would I or anyone select "Standard" and expect to get the Flight Flex or seat selection & other 4 items listed on the pop up window when it does not correlate to the header verbage at the top of the pop up window?! So I naturally selected & joined the \$9 Fare Club (Paid add'I \$59.95) so I would get the option for changing itinerary if needed.
