I write in response to your Public Records Act request dated October 21, 2019, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience.

For all documents concerning complaints against "The Edge" and "All Breed," we estimate that searching for (30 minutes of work has already been performed), reviewing, and redacting the files (6 complaints amounting to 25 files) will come to approximately 155 minutes. Note that there is no charge for the first 30 minutes. At 125 minutes, billed at the lowest possible rate under the Secretary of State's fee schedule (\$.33 a minute), the cost of your Public Records Act request is an estimated \$41.25.

The above estimate excludes complaints concerning "A Canine Gem", since those documents will be provided per your Public Records Act request dated October 16, 2019.
