I write in response to your Public Records Act request dated, February 23, 2020, a copy of which is attached for your convenience.

For all "copies of consumer complaints" against "Tesla Inc ('Tesla')" filed between January 1, 2017 and February 20, 2020, we estimate that searching for, reviewing, and redacting the files (15 complaints amounting to 23 files, two of which exceed 50 pages) will come to approximately 124 minutes. Note that there is no charge for the first 30 minutes. At 94 minutes, billed at the lowest possible rate under the Secretary of State's fee schedule (\$.33 a minute), the cost of your Public Records Act request is an estimated \$ 31.02.

"Copies of consumer complaints" will include the original documents submitted by consumers to the Vermont Attorney General's Consumer Assistance Program (CAP). This cost estimate accounts for just those files. It does not account for additional correspondence files between CAP, the consumer, and the business. If you would like to request those additional files, an adjusted cost estimate would be necessary.
