Dear Chris Malloy:

I write in response to your request for public records, dated November 11, 2020 and, due to a state holiday, received on November 12, 2020. You requested:

[R]ecords that exist on the defunct Vershire School that was in existence from 1968-1988. Specifically, there was reporting done in 1988 about an AG investigation in coordination with the dept of education regarding the school.

Pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. §§ 318(b)(5)(A) and 318(b)(5)(C), the Attorney General's Office will need to invoke its right to an extension of the deadline to 10 business days. Calculating the extended deadline in anticipation of the Thanksgiving holiday, the new deadline for this request is November 30, 2020.
