I write in response to your request for public records, dated January 20, 2021, and received by the Vermont Attorney General's Office on January 25, 2021.

Your request is very broad and includes not only requests for records but for information. Information, however, does not fall within the scope of the Vermont Public Records Act. More resources about the Vermont Public Records Act can be found on the <u>"Open Government</u>" tab of our website. Note that responses to requests for public records are provided free of charge only for the first 30 minutes of time spent complying with the request. Beyond 30 minutes, we follow the Vermont Secretary of State's <u>Uniform Charge Schedule</u>.
