The first with the Vermont Attorney General's office, and a second with the State Attorney for Orange County. I regret that I have no case numbers and only the following information from a New York Times articles dated April 5, 1989 Section B page 13:

In 1988 the Vermont Attorney General's office began an investigation into The Vershire School, Judgment Ridge, Vershire, Vermont 05079 according to Brian Burgess, an Assistant Attorney at the time. The investigation came after reports of rampant drug abuse, sexual misconduct between faculty and students, falsification of student transcripts, and unsafe living conditions. The director of the Vershire school was Richard Wright. The school closed in October 1988.

In addition, the State's Attorney for Orange County brought sexual assault charges against a former teacher of the Vershire School who was accused of having had a homosexual relationship with a student.

I will also contact the Vermont State Department to try and search their records.
