Dear Professor Clopton,

Thank you for your time today on the telephone. This email confirms receipt of your public record request received February 4, 2021.

You asked for: “access to and copies of information related to notices sent to the Office of the Attorney General pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005, specifically 28 U.S.C. § 1715. In particular, I ask that the Office produce a list of all cases in which the Office received such a notice, including the case name, case number, and court. In addition, if possible, I also request any information about any response the Office made to the notice in court, including but not limited to intervening in the case, objecting to the settlement, or filing an *amicus* brief.”

I called you today to request clarification of your request. You told me that a log of the information (not the notices themselves) would suffice. Unfortunately, we do not have a record responsive to your request for a log of CAFA notices. You told me that you do not require the notices themselves. Accordingly, that portion of your request is satisfied by our response of “no responsive records” (with respect to a log).

You also told me that you are interested for any responses by our office to any CAFA notice (in the form of any objection, filing, or amicus brief, e.g.), and you said that since this is for academic purposes you will extend the time for response to a “reasonable time” and/or until we can get back to you with an estimate for cost of production, or if we have confirmation that there are no responsive records. Thank you for your flexibility with respect to time for production.
