Dear Liam:

I write in response to your request for public records dated April 13, 2021. You requested the following public records:

[A] list of all investigations since 1/1/2017 by the Attorney General's office into officer involved shootings, police use-of-force incidents, and other allegations of misconduct by officers, either on-duty or off-duty.

In addition to this request for records, you asked for the following information: "For each investigation, I would like to know the date it was opened, the officers involved, where the incident occur[r]ed, the outcome of the investigation, what was being investigated and how the case was referred to the AGO's office."

Pursuant to the Vermont Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. § 318(b)(5)(A), the Attorney General's Office will need to invoke its right to an extension of the deadline to 10 business days. The new deadline for this request is April 27, 2021.
