Mr. Heck:

On June 7, 2021, you requested any "Notice to the VT AGO from Marlboro College under 11B V.S.A §12.02(g) when Marlboro College entered into a 99-year lease agreement with the Marlboro Music Festival and also gave them right of first refusal for purchase the campus." We have no such records. Generally, a public benefit corporation would not be required to provide our Office with notice under this provision in relation to entering into a lease agreement.

In case it's helpful, and as you're aware, in response to a prior Public Records Act request of yours, on 7-24-20, our Office produced to you the Amended and Restated Lease Agreement as between the Corporation of Marlboro College and the Marlboro Music Festival, Inc., dated Jan. 22, 2019.
