

My office received a request for public records from you on Monday, December 6, 2021. You requested:

1. Employment application and resume of former employee Molly Gray, DOB



On Tuesday, December 7, 2021, I left you a message concerning the scope of your request. More specifically, pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(7), personnel information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act. There are, however, exceptions. State of Vermont Policy 5.4 "Personnel Records," available here, provides insights as to these exceptions. Among the records you requested, an employment application and resume are exempt from the PRA and we are unable to produce those to you. However, Molly Gray's "position title, annual salary history, and employment dates" are considered public information. My question is whether you wish to receive this public information or whether you prefer to receive "records indicating" this public information? If the former, I can get that to you pretty quickly. If we are to gather records, review them, and redact them, as needed, I may need to put together a cost estimate for you, depending on how many records we find.
