I write in response to your Public Records Act request dated February 24, 2022, a copy of which is attached for your convenience.

For "all consumer complaints made to the Vermont Attorney General's office that reference Vail Resorts Inc ("Vail Resorts") from January 1, 2020, to February 23, 2022," our office searched our database for written complaints submitted for complaint mediation, which included Vail Resorts the matter title and located 26 consumer complaints amounting to 105 files. We estimate that searching for, reviewing, and redacting these files will come to approximately 1188 minutes. Note that there is no charge for the first 30 minutes.

For at least 1158 minutes, billed at the lowest possible rate under the Secretary of State's fee schedule (\$.33 a minute), the cost of your Public Records Act request is an estimated \$382.14.
