On behalf of the Vermont Attorney General Office (AGO) Civil Rights Unit (CRU), I am writing to respond to your November 22, 2022 Public Records Request sent via email, in which you requested:

- EEOC letter dated September 7, 2022 for Charge NO. 523-2022-01027 concerning Vermont Associates for Training and Development
- Emails concerning EEOC Charge NO. 523-2022-01027 sent or received between September 1, 2022 and present
- Emails referencing Vermont Associates for Training and Development, A4TD, or Vermont Associates, sent or received between September 1, 2022 and present
- Emails concerning the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) grant sent or received between September 1, 2022 and present

Your request is governed by Vermont's Public Records Act (PRA), 1 V.S.A. §§ 315-320.

Given that the AGO received your request shortly before the Thanksgiving holiday, we require an extension of time, not to exceed 10 business days from your request (by December 8, 2022), to review our files and consult with other divisions to identify and make available any responsive records subject to PRA inspection and copying. *See* 1 V.S.A. § 318(b)(5).
